Literacy

In literacy, we will initially be working on biographies and writing these about superheroes. Pupils will be inventing their own fictional hero and generating their own biography for them, which will be shared with Year 4 children.

Following this, we are going to be writing traditional tales with a twist and using the tale of 'The Stinky Cheeseman' as our context to entertain Year 2 children.

Maths

In class, we will be looking at place value initially as well as rounding and estimating. We will be looking at moving pupils towards mastery of these skills before we look at the written calculation methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Following this we will aim to use these methods in problems solving activities before rounding off the term looking at fractions.

<u>Science</u>

We are studying light this halfterm in science.

After an initial lesson to gauge what pupils already know about the topic, we will be exploring how light travels, how colours are made and we will even make our own periscopes using our knowledge.

In addition, we will be looking at how we use light to see using the human eye and how the process works.

As well as that, they will be developing art skills by creating their own Maya god using paint and creating a Maya skull from clay before decorating it.
