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Class 'Reading Together' Challenge 2018/19

Dear Parents/Carers,

This year we are challenging pupils to help their class to read more than all the rest in our new class 'Reading Together' challenge.

Due to pupils' feedback and data we looked at, the challenge has been re-vamped and will work as stated below.

- As last year, each pupil to receive a 'Reading Challenge Record'. This is to be filled in by parents/teachers when a child has read part of a book for enjoyment - One read is allowed per day to be logged in the 'Reading Challenge Record'. (However, you can read more than once a day but it won't count towards the challenge!)
- Each read a pupil does will gain their class a point, which will be entered onto their class's Dojo record.
- Weekly, the class, which has read the most within that week, will receive a PRIZE.
- Each half-term, the class, that has the most points in total will receive an EXPERIENCE as reward for their hard work.
- After each half-term, the challenge will be re-set and all classes will compete again from zero.
- Individual pupils who read continually throughout the entire year and achieve a very high percentage of reads, will receive a reward EXPERIENCE in the last half-term of the academic year.
- Books are to come from the age related sections of the book trolley/library.
- There will be a specific day (dictated by classes) for pupils to bring in their books to change from the book trolley.
- The books can be read at home or in school.
