# Literacy

In literacy, we will be first looking at writing scary introductions to a horror movie as we will have just had Halloween.

Following this, we will be writing a description of the adaptive traits, which animals have evolved with.

After that, we will be writing a recount about the voyage and discoveries of Charles Darwin.

Finally, we will be writing poems about a robin returning home for Christmas based on the Michael Morpurgo book 'Coming Home'.

## <u>Maths</u>

In class, we will be continuing work on fractions; looking at multiplying and dividing them.

Then, pupils will be looking at decimals and percentages and converting between the three. In addition, we will look at problem solving involving the maths taught and finally ratio.

Later in the term, we will be doing a music week looking at the film scores of 'John Williams'.
